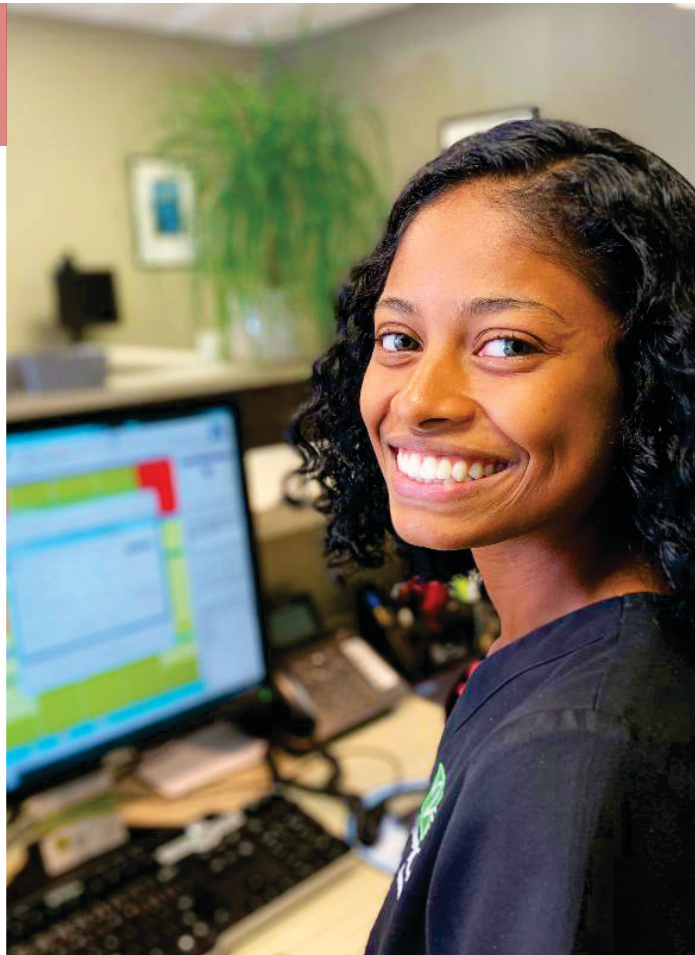

The Federal government, along with every state legislature recognizes three major professionals as physicians, the Allopathic (MD), Osteopathic (DO) and Chiropractic (DC). The Chiropractic Assistants (CAs) performs many of the Administrative duties, as well as help the Chiropractor, depending upon the academic training, knowledge, experience and abilities of the Chiropractic Assistant.

Due to the significant increase in 'Senior' population, as well as continuing research & development of special programs by the Chiropractic Physicians in pain-management and family-medicine, the profession of Chiropractic medicine has become more rewarding, challenging and highly specialized. The Chiropractic Assistants have also become much more important & valuable for a successful Chiropractic practice.

Competency Based accelerated programs, based on credit for previous studies, experience, research or examination, may allow you to complete the program in less time. Most courses, including Continuing Education Programs, may be available on-campus, on-line or a combination thereof. Labs & Clinical Training (Internship) however must be completed at the school and/or at designated facility.
