ESL (English As a Second Language) Teachers, often referred to as TESOL or TEFL, are very much in demand at local academic institutions, community organizations, churches, immigration help centers and other organizations which help the new immigrants & refugees. ESL teachers are also being hired by Literacy Councils and Organizations dedicated to improve literacy among American adults and youth who are unable to read & write English.

Since English has become the primary universal language, there is a huge demand for ESL Teachers overseas, especially in Latin America, the Middle East and Asia (China, Japan, Korea, Vietnam, etc.). While jobs are plentiful, most foreign schools now require Certification with a minimum of 100 hours of ESL Teacher Training. This 12-week Certification Program is especially designed for students with a minimum of a Bachelor's Degree, while the 1-Year Diploma program is designed for those with an Associate Degree or equivalent, plus experience in ESL teaching.

We require that our students exhibit excellent interpersonal communication, organizational & negotiation skills, and be able to develop high levels of technical competence across areas of education, be knowledgeable about world cultures, religions, economy and languages. This program is available online or on-campus. We meet at least once each week for one-on-one discussion, seminars & workshops. New classes start in January, April, July and October.
