

HOMEOPATHIC MEDICINE

Medical Treatment is an Art and a Science. For centuries we have experimented with a number of modalities, starting with the 5000 years old Indian Ayurvedic Medicine, Chinese Traditional Medicine, followed by the treatment with natural substances used in Europe & Middle East.

During the 18th century, bloodletting became the norm, killing millions all over the world, including our first President, George Washington, who died on December 17, 1799, after a simple soarthroat. The concept of HOMEOPATHIC MEDICAL SYSTEM spread very quickly all over the world. By 1892, the United States had over four hundred state and county Homeopathic Associations and by 1912 there were 195 Homeopathic Hospitals, nine of which had more than one hundred beds.

influences. The curative remedies are based on the underlying cause and not necessarily symptoms. Homeopathy also offers nutritional, psychological, social & environmental guidelines to prevent disease or to avoid acute illnesses from progressing into chronic conditions.
