Community Health Workers (CHWs) work with hospitals, clinics, health insurance companies & other providers offering evidence-based skillful conversation, knowledge and strategies for assessing, screening, documenting, coordinating & developing sustainable health care programs, to actively and safely engage client/patient in self-care, health behavior/lifestyle change and attain optimal health, thus helping reduce the burgeoning cost of healthcare.

- The 160 clock-hours program can be completed in 3-months
- The Cost of Program is \$850.00 plus Admission Fee of \$100.00.
- The training may include internship/volunteering at local hospitals, clinics, community centers, etc.
- Financial support may be available from the State, Hospitals, Insurance Companies, MCC & Foundations, etc.
- Community Health Workers are licensed Healthcare Professionals in many states but NOT in Michigan as yet.
