The Home Health Aides (HHA) provide basic, non-medical, routine personal care to the elderly, physically compromised, hospice patients, individuals with long-term illnesses, adults with mental disabilities, such as dementia or Alzheimer Disease, including children & youth with disabilities or mental illness.

With the elderly population growing significantly, demand for qualified Home Health Aides have increased considerably, especially for the HHAs who have a formal training in the skills required to take care of the growing needs of those who prefer to stay at their own home, rather be institutionalized.

The demand for qualified HHAs has also increased due to COVID-19, significant increase in Drug-Abuse & Mental Health Issues in Youth & Elderly, significant shortage of Social Workers & Mental Health Professionals, plus cost-containment efforts and more personalized services provided by Home Health Aides.

We require that our students exhibit excellent interpersonal communication, soft-skills such as empathy, organizational & negotiating skills, leadership, decision-making and the ability to develop high levels of medical and technological competencies across a wide variety of disciplines. A genuine desire to help the client become physically and mentally healthier is fundamental and required to be a successful Medical Assistant.

Competency-based accelerated program, based on exemptions, credits for previous studies, experience, research or examination may allow you to complete the program in less than 75 hours. Many of the courses can be completed with guided self-study & YouTube labs. Some classes, workshops and labs may also be held at AAIE campus, including practical training. Internship & practical training may be provided at the school's clinic open to public, and possibly at hospitals, clinics & healthcare providers' offices, senior centers, community centers, etc.
